Peggy Eastman is Poet-in-Residence at All Saints. She is a graduate of Vassar College and the Education for Ministry program of the School of Theology, University of the South, a theological extension program.

She is the author of *Godly Glimpses: Discoveries of the Love That Heals*, which received an award from Capital Christian Writers; and *Ten Women of the Bible: Witnesses to Faith*, a book of poetry. She is also co-author of *Your Child Is Smarter Than You Think*. Her work has appeared in many periodicals and anthologies; her poetry has received awards in annual contests sponsored by *Writer's Digest*. For many years Peggy was editor of Share magazine, a quarterly inspirational publication of the Catholic Daughters of the Americas. She was a "Guideposts" magazine contest winner and has contributed stories to "Guideposts," its sister publication "Angels on Earth," and a number of "Guideposts" books.

Peggy has pursued a career as a medical/science writer since completing a fellowship in science writing at the National Institutes of Health (NIH). She served as editor of "American Pharmacy" magazine and served as Washington contributing writer for "Women's Health Advisor" consumer newsletter, published under the auspices of Cornell University. She is currently a contributing writer for "Oncology Times," published by Lippincott Williams & Wilkins.

She has served as a consulting writer for the National Alliance for the Mentally Ill, the National Arthritis Advisory Board, the National Diabetes Advisory Board, and the National Institute on Alcohol Abuse and Alcoholism, among others.
