- 7:45 people will now have the offerings after worship they have been seeking.
- The 9 o'clock service and our 10 o'clock Christian Ed will simply flip time slots.
- Introducing a rich, powerful, and vibrant array of "All Saints University" classes.
- The University classes will include Kingdom Living Classes by the Rector, Spiritual Gifts courses, PhD taught courses, Alpha in the Morning, small groups, and much more.
- Continental breakfast will be available throughout the morning.
