PARKING

Let's be a welcoming church! Please remember that the parking lot is reserved on Sundays for first-time visitors and those who need close access to the building for physical reasons.

Also, we have been informed by the Village Police that there have been numerous parking violations on Sunday mornings. In order to avoid a citation, please remember that - in addition to other parking prohibitions - one must NOT park:

- In violation of an official sign;
- Within 5 feet of a driveway opening;
- Within 30 feet of a stop sign or other traffic device;
- Within 15 feet of a fire hydrant;
- Within 2 feet of another vehicle;
- More than 1 foot from the curb; or
- Opposite the flow of traffic
