

Annual Giving Campaign for 2021 - Frequently Asked Questions

Why pledge?

Pledging is an act of faith on the part of each parishioner, and a concrete promise to support God's work next year through our local parish. Pledges allow the Vestry and staff to generate an annual budget based on prayer, wisdom, and sound knowledge of likely giving during 2021.

I GIVE online. Can I also PLEDGE online?

Yes! We encourage you to do both - links are available on our website giving page. If you pledge online, there is no need to also mail your pledge card.

When are pledges due?

Commitment Sunday is November 15, the day we dedicate our pledges to the Lord and thank him for blessing us and - more importantly - for blessing others through us. Don't wait, though - the sooner your get your pledge in, the better for planning purposes!

What if I cannot fulfill my pledge?
